Cut out the animal shapes. Below, or on another piece of paper, glue animals the in a matching pattern.

Pattern 1:

Graders, Students can use whichever animal they want to complete the pattern. Use your best judgement.

For example,

Bear, Cat, Owl, Bear, Cat, Owl

Pattern 2:

Graders, Students can use whatever animal they want to complete the pattern.

For example,

Bear, Cat, Owl, Bear, Cat, Owl, Bear

Since they can use whichever animal for their pattern, it may mimic the one above.

Example

Bear, Bear, Owl, Bear, Bear, Cat, Bear

Take a pattern scavenger hunt.

Go outside and look for any patterns you see. These can be natural, or man-made.

Here are some patterns to watch for:

Natural: stripes on a bird, seed heads, frost/ice/snow (bring a magnifying glass), animal tracks, the branches of trees, pine cones

Man-made: lines on the road, fences, street lights, brick walls, siding on houses, sidewalks

Draw three pictures of what you saw.

Graders, use your best judgement. Check for completion. Err on the side of completing the task.
